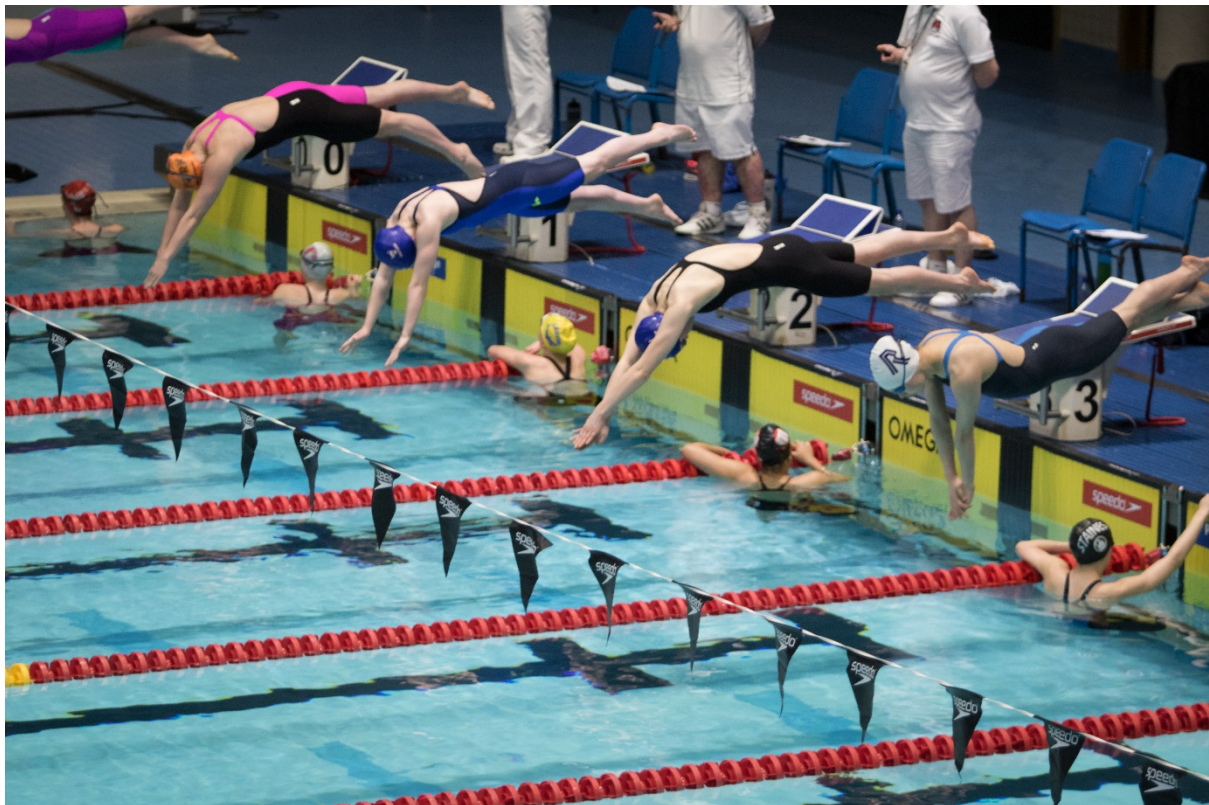


## City of Sheffield Premier Open Meet

City of Oxford swimmers enjoyed a highly successful City of Sheffield Premier Open Gala from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March. Leading the way was 16 year old Emily Nisbet who took 3 gold medals in the girls 15 years /over category, winning the 200m freestyle (2.08.50), 200m individual medley (2.26.49) and 200m butterfly (2.21.94). Fellow 16 year old Emily Wood took gold in the girls' 15/over 200m breaststroke in 2.35.42 with silvers in the 100m breaststroke in 1.13.46 and 50m breaststroke (34.66). Natasha Fenton took gold in the girls' 14/under 200m breaststroke in 2.42.38. Annie Sharp added a silver in the girl's 15/Over 200m backstroke (2.24.62) with Ellie Millington taking two further silver medals in the girls' 15/over 50m freestyle (27.28) and 100m freestyle in 58.73. Kate Mills added a bronze in the Girl's open 50m butterfly (29.11).

David Murphy took gold in the boys 15/over 200m breaststroke in a new Oxfordshire & North Bucks county record of 2.18.73 with Callum Smart taking silver in 2.22.80. Murphy added gold in the 100m breaststroke in 1.02.87 and silver in the 50m breaststroke (29.08). Fabian Whitbread took gold medals in the 15/over 200m backstroke in 2.10.34 and 200m IM in 2.07.27.

City swimmers also added a number of individual age group medals with full results available on the City of Sheffield Swimming Club website.
