To be responsible for the overall development and transition of swimmers through the COSC Learn to Swim Programme into the wider club in Rising Stars. To work closely with local swimming lessons to talent ID and liaise with interested parents.

Key Tasks:

Deliver Coaching to Rising Stars/Development Squads:

- Delivery of sessions for Rising Stars Bronze squad alongside Lead Coach.
- Deliver all sessions in line with City of Oxford's Health and Safety and Inclusion policies and with consideration of Safeguarding policies.

- To deliver any land training needed for the squad in line with the Lead Coach.
- To record swimmers' attendance on the registers.
- To encourage swimmers to enter competitions as per the competition calendar set by the Head Coach and advise swimmers what events to enter.
- Attendance at competitions as required.
- Talent identification of any swimmers in line with squad criteria as set by the lead coach and head coach.
- To assist with land training for the squad.
- To help ensure all Rising Stars Sessions are covered in case of absence.

Administrative Responsibilities:

- Dealing with complaints and ensuring that these are escalated where necessary to the line manager.
- To deal with enquiries and communication from parents in a timely and professional manner.
